






Food assistance
The HOPE Act, passed in 2015 and 2016, added barriers and restrictions for people applying for and participating in SNAP (food assistance in Kansas) and administered by the Department for Children and Families (DCF).
KAC and partner organizations are currently working to peel back thus repetite business. back two specific barriers:






